## TAMED QUAIL SHOOTING DOG TRAINING PERMIT REGULATIONS

- 1. Upon written application, any individual or organized shooting dog training field trial association or group may obtain a <u>Tamed Quail Shooting Dog Training Permit.</u>
- 2. Said permit shall be issued for a period of one year upon payment of a fee of \$5.29.
- 3. The permit or permit number shall be attached at all times to each release or capture pen, and all tamed quail so used shall be identified through the use of leg brands or dye on the wing or wings of each released bird.
- 4. When so permitted and identified by dye or leg brands, tamed quail may be possessed, released, hunted, shot and killed or retaken for shoot-to-kill field trial and dog training activities using release or capture pens during any season of the year.
- 5. <u>No Tamed Quail Shooting Dog Training Permit</u> shall authorize or extend the statutory season for operation of licensed private or commercial shooting preserves except for bona fide bird dogs training operations as permitted under these regulations.
- Professional dog trainers shall be required to obtain a <u>Tamed Quail Shooting Dog</u>
  <u>Training Permit</u> whenever it is anticipated that any tamed and marked quail are to be
  shot during the progress of any dog training activities in compliance with these
  regulations.
