Law Enforcement

Chief Adcock stated there have been no public comments made regarding the intent version of LE4- 3779 and staff recommends approval of the final version.

ACTION: Upon motion made by Commissioner Rigdon and seconded by Commissioner Munro, Public Notice LE4-3779 (Nuisance Animals) (Final) was unanimously approved.

Chief Adcock presented an update on the violations reports and stated there were two (2) drowning incidents on the Pearl River this past weekend. At this time of year, the boating incidents tend to be less; however, staff continues to have boating details in place. As far as the oil spill disaster in the Gulf, MDWFP staff is assisting the Department of Marine Resources in guarding the booms in the gulf that are set up to trap the oil spill. MDWFP has trained personnel for the oil spill disaster and are ready for MEMA to call when needed. The Museum staff and fisheries are helping by providing information to the Natural Resources Disaster Assistance Program (NRDA) with mitigating problems associated with the oil spill disaster.

Public Comments Regarding Agenda Items

RE: Hog Hunting on the Leaf River:

Tommy Newman, President of South MS Sportsman Association

Opposes hog hunting with dogs at Leaf River WMA. Since today's report by the Wildlife Division, he believes his concerns have been addressed and resolved already. Also, Mr. Newman suggested lifting the ban on Sunday hunting at Chickasawhay, Red Creek, and Mason Creek WMAs. A lot of complaints have been received by campers who can't do a one-day hunt.

Chuck Stein, Public Relations

Opposes hog hunting at Leaf River WMA. He stated there are two (2) hunting areas at Leaf River – (1) dog hunters and (2) still hunting for deer, etc. Public Notice W16-3451 (Leaf River) will upset the natural quietness in the still hunt area.

Betty Spooner

There is no hog problem at Leaf River. She opposes Public Notice W16-3451 that allows hog hunting with dogs at Leaf River WMA.
