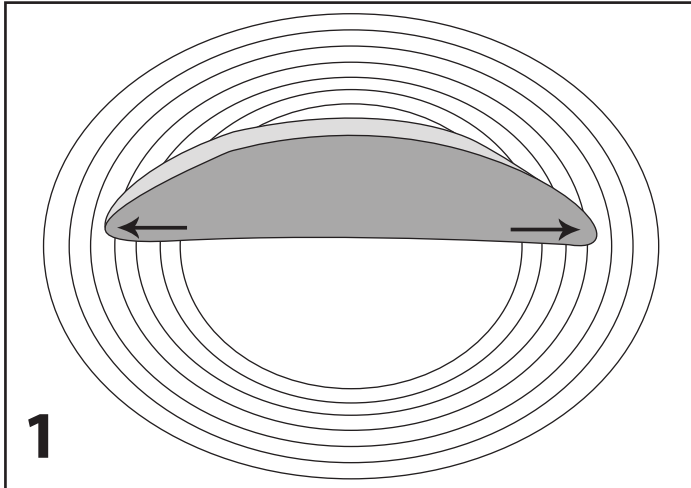
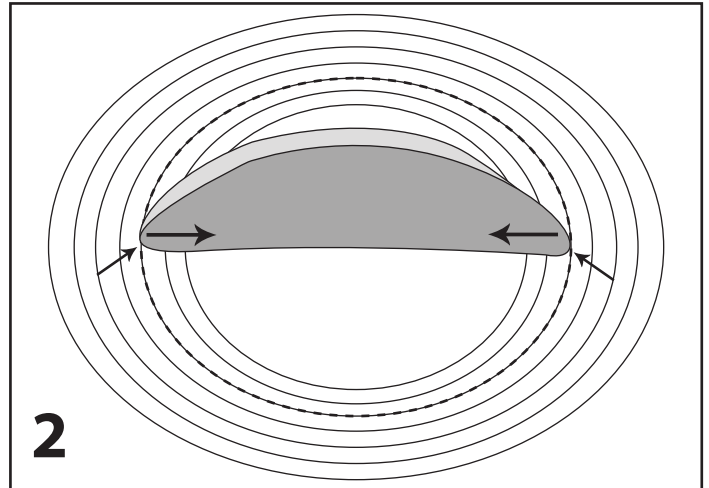


# How to Board a Beaver to the Proper Size



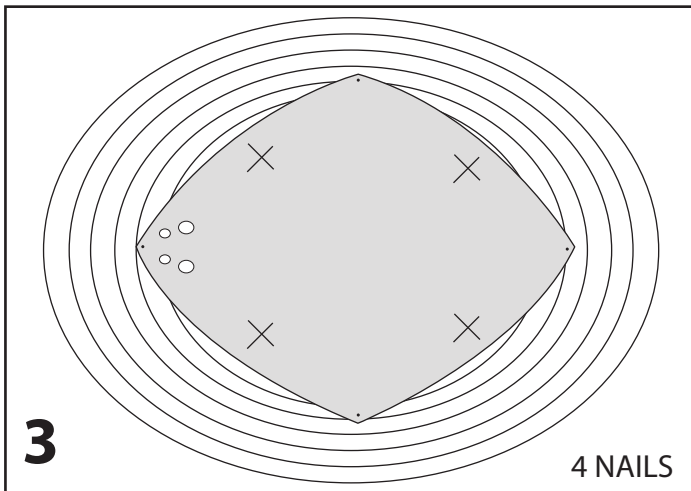
**1**

Fold the beaver pelt lengthwise on the board. Center the pelt within the size rings and pull out.



**2**

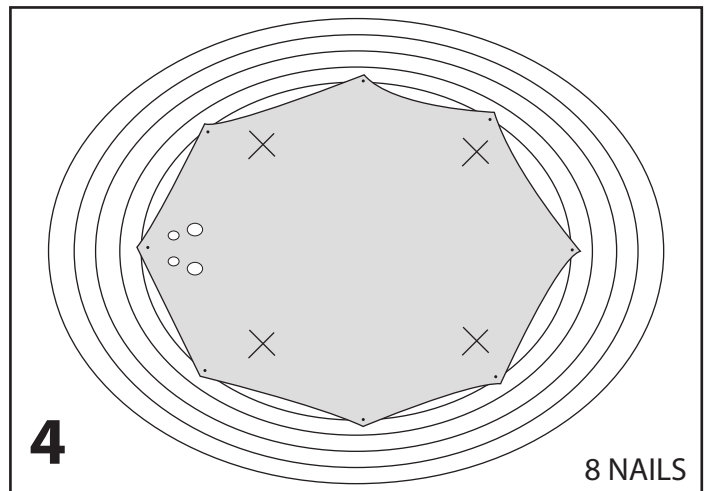
Release the pelt and allow it to return to its natural length, then choose the correct sizing line.



**3**

4 NAILS

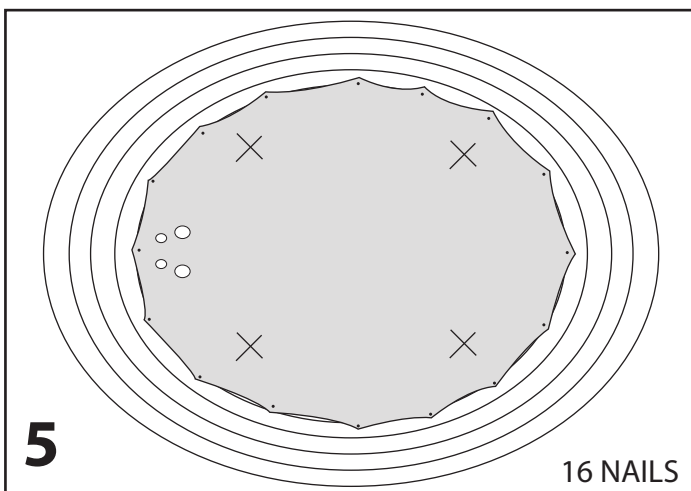
Begin with four nails. One at the nose, one at the tail, and one on each flank.



**4**

8 NAILS

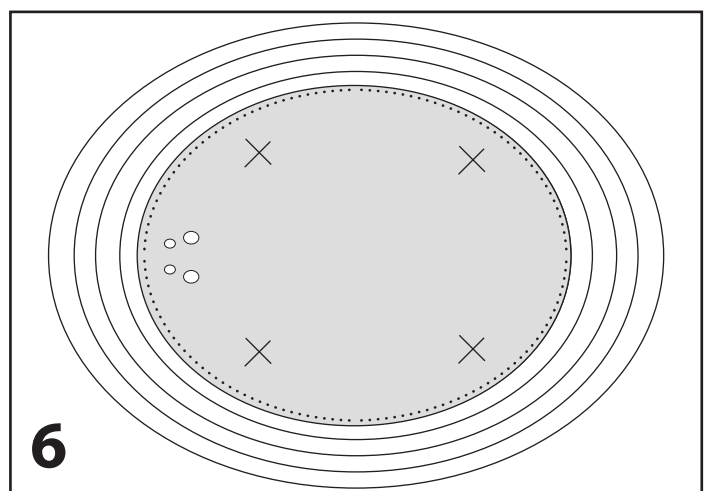
Add another four nails, one near each leg.



**5**

16 NAILS

Add nails in between the others. At this point, if you have difficulty stretching the pelt and securing the nails, you might want to consider dropping down half a size.



**6**

Finish nailing the rest of the pelt using at gap of one inch. It should be taut but not tight
