



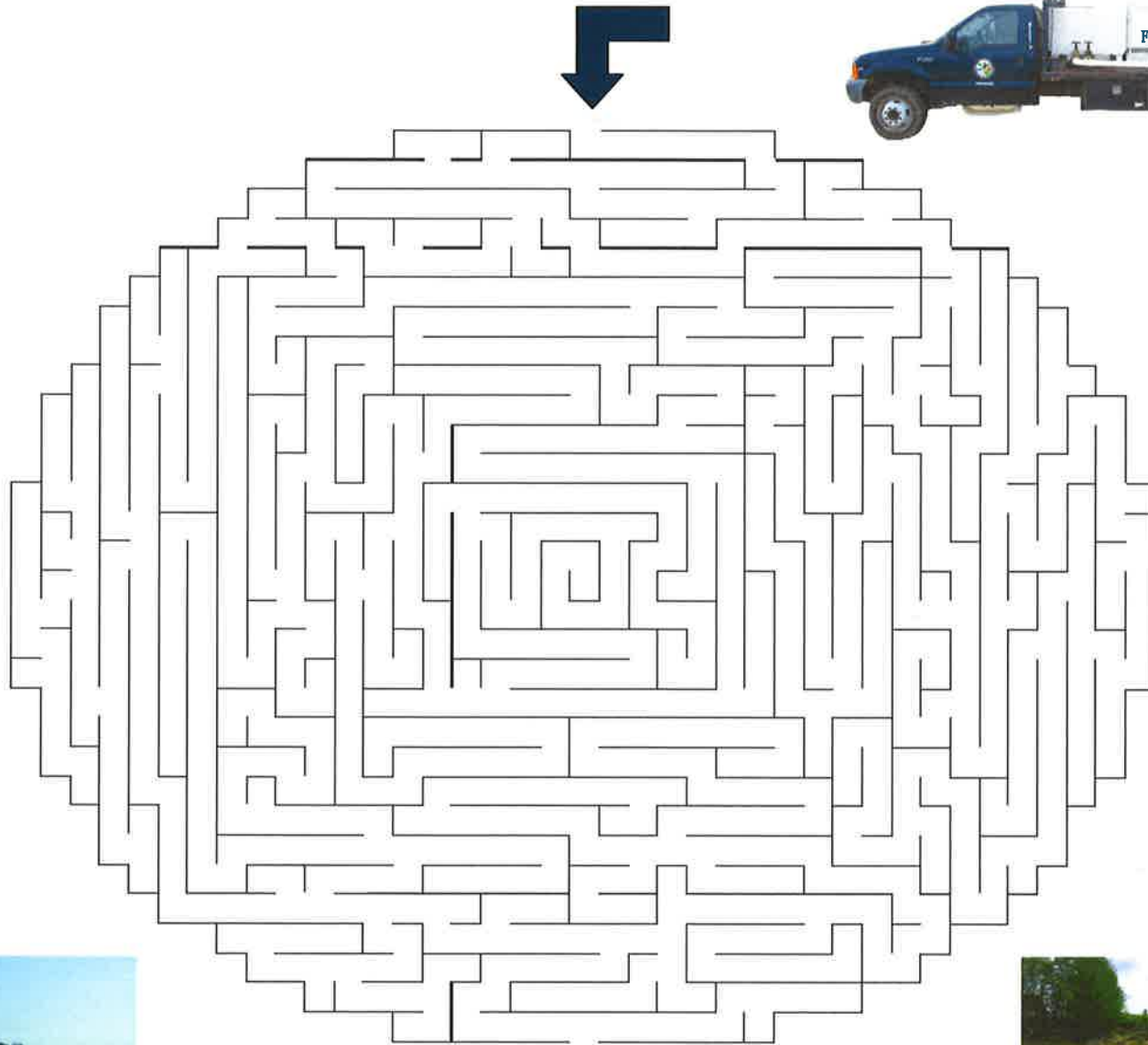
Help the hatchery truck get to the lakes!

How do fish from the hatchery get into the lakes?

After the fish eggs hatch inside the hatchery, the fry (newly hatched fish) are stocked into hatchery ponds.

These fish grow 1 - 2 inches long. In the fall, hatchery workers take these fish out of the ponds and put them into a truck like the one you see in the picture. They stock them to lakes across the state.

The next time you are fishing, you may be catching a fish raised at the North Mississippi Fish Hatchery!
