



3. Fingerlings

After the fry have formed mouths, they are placed into hatchery ponds where they feed on plankton. These fish are harvested in the fall when they reach 2 to 4 inches in length. These fish are called fingerlings. Fingerlings are then stocked in lakes and ponds across Mississippi.
