| Northern long-eared bat | <i>Myotis septentrionalis</i> | Threatened | Caves, mines, culverts, trees |
| Rafinesque's big-eared bat | <i>Corynorhinus rafinesquii</i> | Species of Special Concern | Hollow tree, bridges, cisterns, culverts, abandoned buildings |
| Southeastern myotis | <i>Myotis austroriparius</i> | Species of Special Concern | Caves, culverts, hollow tress, bridges |
| Silver-haired bat | <i>Lasionycteris noctivagans</i> | Species of Special Concern | Hollow trees, buildings |
| Hoary bat | <i>Aeorestes cinereus</i> | Species of Special Concern | Tree foliage |
| Northern yellow bat | <i>Dasypterus intermedius</i> | Species of Special Concern | Spanish moss, palmettos |
| Little brown bat | <i>Myotis lucifugus</i> | Species of Special Concern | Caves, mines, trees, buildings |
| Big brown bat | <i>Eptesicus fuscus</i> | Common | Mines, caves, trees, bridges, culverts, buildings |
| Eastern red bat | <i>Lasiurus borealis</i> | Common | Tree foliage |
| Seminole bat | <i>Lasiurus seminolus</i> | Common | Tree foliage, Spanish moss |
| Tri-colored bat | <i>Perimyotis subflavus</i> | Common | Caves, mines, trees, culverts |
| Brazilian free-tailed bat | <i>Tadarida brasiliensis</i> | Common | Caves, bridges, buildings, culverts |
| Evening bat | <i>Nycticeius humeralis</i> | Common | Trees, buildings |
